Forklift Seat - A seat is a sturdy, sturdy surface to sit upon, typically raised above floor level. The seat back can be designed as an included headrest by extending the height above the occupant's head. Seats could be constructed together with an attached, built in footrest or come with a separate matching ottoman. An ottoman is a short stool which is designed to be utilized as a movable footrest.
